

ORDINANCE NO. 146

An Ordinance of the City of Amity, Arkansas, passed and approved on the 29 day of Sept, 1986, closing the Amity City Dump; providing for garbage pickup by Clark County, Arkansas; declaring an emergency; and for other purposes.

Section I. WHEREAS, the City of Amity, Arkansas, finds and declares it to be reasonable and necessary, and it is hereby ordained by the City Council of Amity, Arkansas: That the Amity City Dump shall be closed because of standards, rules, and regulations set by the Environmental Protection Agency and the City's health, safety and welfare.

Section II. Persons who dump garbage or other items at the Amity City Dump hereafter in violation of this ordinance shall be prosecuted to the fullest extent possible under existing Arkansas law.


Section III. That hereafter garbage pickup for the City of Amity, Arkansas, shall be contracted to the County of Clark, Arkansas, at the rate of \$3.00 per month total for each dwelling in the city, said amount including the \$1.50 presently billed to the City of Amity waterworks users for garbage collection.

All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

WHEREAS, there has arisen a serious condition of garbage disposed in the City of Amity, Arkansas, which

vitaly affects the public welfare; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation and protection of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
