

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 94 OF THE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AMITY, ARKANSAS, PASSED AND APPROVED ON THE 1ST DAY OF MAY, 1972, FIXING RATES FOR SEWER AND WATER SERVICES FURNISHED BY THE CITY OF AMITY, ARKANSAS.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and declares to be reasonable and necessary because of increased costs of operation and the need for improvements in the City of Amity water works that Section 2 of Ordinance No. 94, passed and approved on the 1st day of May, 1972, be amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. The following monthly rates are hereby fixed as rates to be charged for water furnished and services rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Amity, Arkansas, which rates the City Council finds and declares to be reasonable and necessary minimum rates to be charged beginning January ____ 1976:

WATER RATES	
CONSUMPTION	RATES
For the first 3,000 gallons of water, or less	\$.360
For the next 22,000 gallons.	\$.1.00 per 1,000 gallons
For the next 25,000 gallons.	\$. .75 per 1,000 gallons
All over 50,000 gallons.	\$. .50 per 1,000 gallons
Minimum monthly charge	\$.360

The cost of operation and need for improvement for the City of Amity Waterworks System have increased rapidly since May, 1972, and, therefore, it is declared that an emergency exists, that this amendment to Ordinance No. 94 is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from

and immediately after its passage.
