

AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 98

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR CURFEW OF ALL PERSONS WITHIN THE CITY OF AMITY; AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith; PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AMITY, ARKANSAS, THAT ORDINANCE NO. 98 IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ:

SECTION 1. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person to stand or loiter upon any of the streets, alleys, sidewalks and other public places in the City of Amity after 10:00 P.M. Sundays through Thursdays and after 11:00 P.M. Fridays and Saturdays. Unless flight by the actor or other circumstances makes it impracticable, a policeman or other peace officer shall prior to any arrest under this section afford the actor an opportunity to move on; or to dispel any alarm which would otherwise be warranted by requesting the actor to identify himself and explain his presence and conduct.

SECTION 2. Any person violating Section 1 herein shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) nor more than FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) and each violation shall be deemed to be a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All other ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Whereas, there has arisen a serious condition of persons loitering at late hours of the night on the public streets and places in the City of Amity which vitally affects the public welfare; therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance being immediately necessary for the preservation and protection of the public peace, health, welfare and safety, shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
